
Median household income is **\$9.5K below** the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 1.4%** since 2013, falling by 235. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.3%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 209.

From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 1.3% in Crawford County, WI from 8,543 to 8,434. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.4% by 8.7%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.0% to 59.0% between 2013 and 2018.

Concerning educational attainment, 10.8% of Crawford County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (7.8% below the national average), and 9.9% hold an Associate's Degree (1.9% above the national average).

The top three industries in 2018 are Other Nonmetallic Mineral Product Manufacturing, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Electronic Shopping and Mail-Order Houses.







Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Crawford County, WI has 1,399 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 983.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Crawford County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,622 people 55 or older, while there are 6,212 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Crawford County, WI has 15.56 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation LQ





Top Occupation Earnings


